


#### WHAT IS SOBER LIVING?

# WHAT DO WE OFFER?



We have a beautiful garden and swimming pool, with a covered patio and braai area. Dinner is offered Monday through Thursday, with tea, coffee and milk readily available. Cooking facilities are available.

We have also partnered with the Foundation Clinic's Wellness programme, offering outpatient, aftercare and relapse prevention daily. Each resident also has access to a monthly check-in and coaching session.



# **HOW DO WE WORK?**

We are a 12-step based establishment and follow the guidelines and recommendation of the program. Residents are supported in following the five pillars of the program, including regular meeting attendance and completing step work with a sponsor.


We operate based on a set of house rules and guidelines to ensure that the environment remains healthy, safe and collaborative.

There is a zero-tolerance policy for drugs and alcohol and random drug tests are conducted. Two tests per month are included in our prices.

There is a weekly house meeting to ensure that residents and management meet to discuss everyone's recovery processes as well as any communal house matters.

# What are the residential requirements? Residents are required to:


- Produce a clean drug test on admission.
  - Ideally residents should have completed a treatment or recovery program.
- Actively work on maintaining their sobriety.
- Agree and adhere to the house rules and guidelines.
- Live and work collaboratively and complete the duties outlined on the weekly roster.

#### What are the costs?

- The monthly cost is R7,950/month.
- An additional breakage and remote deposit of R650.
- Additional meals are for residents' own accounts.
